BNEXT is a ministry of Scripture Awakening, which develops a variety of Bible study materials for individuals, small groups, and churches.

While **BNEXT** might seem like a peculiar name for a Bible study series, the name is rooted in the Bible in 90 Days (B90) experience. We know that when B90 groups finish reading the Bible, many raised the question, “What’s next?” Because B90 groups meet consistently for 3 months, they form a connection, an identity, and usually want to continue to meet as a group. So BNEXT provides the opportunity to move from reading the Bible — to studying it — together!

BNEXT accommodates a multifaceted study approach, which can be used in many different ways. BNEXT works not just for small groups, but for individuals as well. Each lesson incorporates personal devotion, small group discussion, and digging deeper questions. BNEXT studies can also be used to engage an entire congregation. When pastors incorporate BNEXT studies with their weekly sermons, they can connect the sermon, small group study, and personal devotions. BNEXT fits any church of any size and denomination. With topical themes, or whole books of the Bible, BNEXT studies provide commentary and thoughtfully constructed questions to facilitate in-depth reflection on the Scriptures. And our BNEXT leadership development resources will help churches build leaders, small groups, and disciples for Christ.

In 2018 we launched the **BNEXT Amazing Journey Bible Study Series** in print, video, and digital (pdf) formats. We reformatted our former Old and New Testament Overviews to replicate the Bible in 90 Days experience, creating 11 printed booklets, and supplemented video content on USB flash drives, which cover the entire Bible from Genesis to Revelation.

This catalog presents the BNEXT studies in groups of different series. Each series differ in the number of weekly lessons each contains. For example, **God’s Good News**, our series based on the Gospels, has four lessons, while our series entitled **The Fruit of the Spirit** has ten lessons. Additional Bible study series are also available: Topical Study Series, Old Testament Book Series and New Testament Book Series. New studies will be added to our catalog in the future.

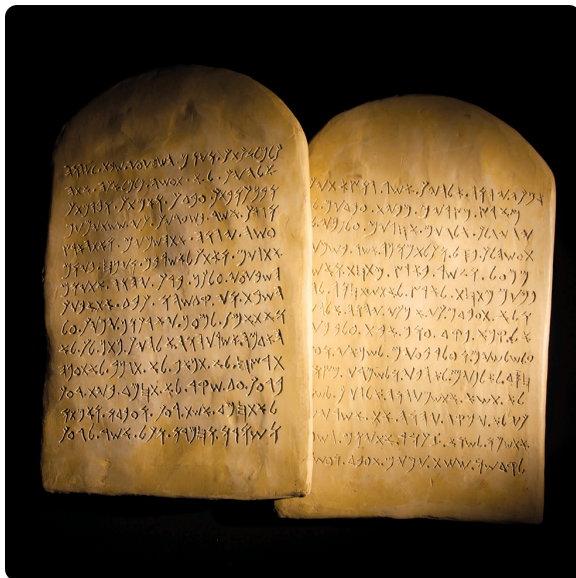
